Wilton May 16, 1776 Anne, dau. of Reuben Olmstead (she b. 1754); bought 28 A Beers' Hill from Samuel Middlebrook; sold to Matthew Keeler 1800; B-R Acct. 1800, sieve rim maker; 1802 lived Beers; Hill; (see George Patchen deed, Ridgefield); (Oct. 1798 Major Comstock, running Ridgefield-Wilton line mentions his house near Beers' Hill; he d. _____.
