Frank B. Jaynes, civil engineer of Bridge, was born April 27, 1871, in the city where he resides, and the fact that the family has a French coat of arms leads him to the belief that the Jaynes in America were originally of French ancestry, the name being De Jean **The line of descent is traced down through William Jaynes, who came to the United States about 1646, through James, Shadrack, Stephen, Nathan and Charles.** The last-named wedded Margaret Somers, a representative of an old Massachusetts family.

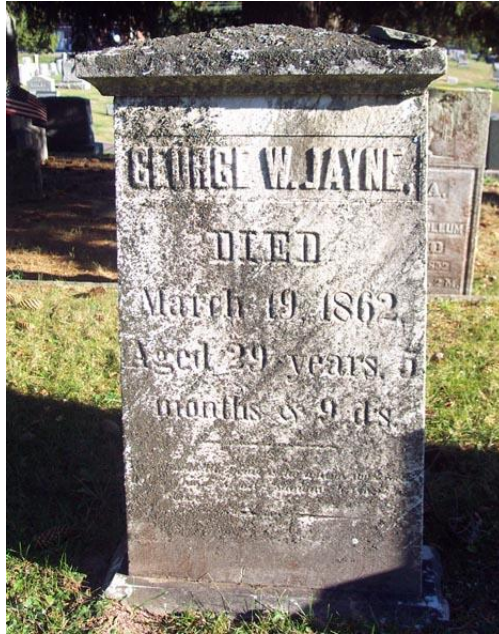

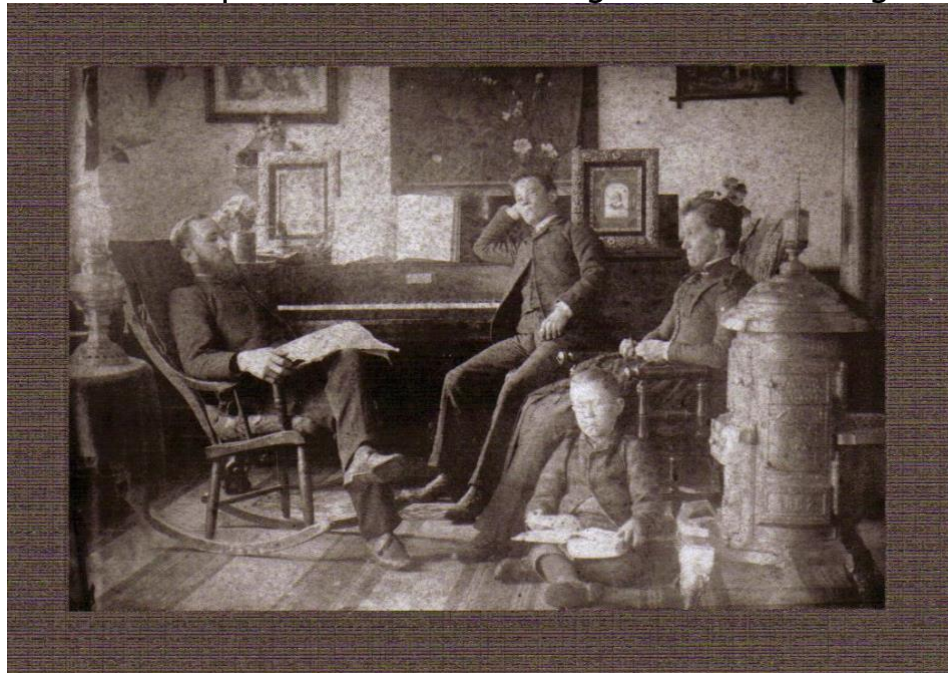

Biographical Annals of Deceased Residents of the West Branch Valley of the Susquehanna, J. F. Meginness, 1899.

John DeLong. b. Stroudsburg, Northampton Co, (now Pike Co.) in 1792---d. Mar. 9, 1888. Located Centre Co., PA in 1845. He was on his way to the far west and stopped in the Nipponese Valley. He bought 100 acres of woodland on top of Sugar Valley mountain and in time cleared the farm which his widow now owns. **His wife's maiden name was Lucretia Jayne, and she was a cousin of the famous and immensely wealthy Dr. Jayne, the patent medicine of Philadelphia.** Mrs. DeLong taught what was known as a "day school" for twenty two years. John DeLong was a cousin of Lt. DeLong, the famous North Pole adventurer. For many years he traveled Center, Clinton and adjoining counties as an agricultural implement salesman.

*Note:* Lucretia Jaynes DeLong was a third cousin of **the famous and immensely wealthy Dr. David Jayne (1799-1866)** of Philadelphia.

Jesse Jaynes was a second cousin of Lt. Ebenezer Jayne (1754-1826).

Shadrach Jaynes was a first cousin of Willam Jayne III (1712-1798).

James Jayne was a brother of William Jayne II (1678-1756).

William Jayne I was the immigrant.

"In 1924 or 1925 my husband and I drove to Bellefonte PA (my home town when I was married). We stopped between Williamsport and Jersey Shore PA for gasoline. In the conversation, the old gentleman that waited on us asked us where we were from. We told him Corning NY. He said he had a cousin that went to Corning and married a James Bedient. It must have been grandpa, but we were in a hurry and that is all we knew." [*Note:* Linden, PA is the only town between Williamsport and Jersey Shore.]

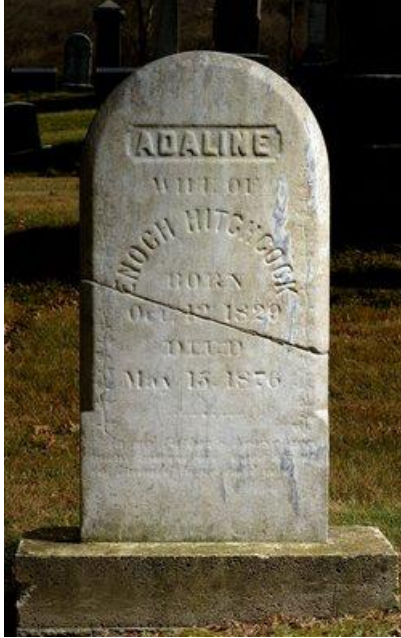

As a young man James Bedient served in Co. F, 15th N.Y. Volunteer Engineers, in the Civil War. While in the service he was injured in a train accident near Little York, PA and received a medical discharge. He was given a disability pension for the rest of his life. Early in life he was a carpenter, but in later years he worked as a cattle dealer. After the death of his third wife Emmeline, James lived on his

farm in Hornby, NY until about 1900 when he moved to a house in Northside, Corning, NY. In the fall of 1905 James went to Deckerville, MI to live with his son Conrad but returned to Corning in April of 1906 to live with his son Henry in whose home he died. He was a member of the Wesleyan Methodist Church at Dyke, a small hamlet in the town of Hornby.

The name of Legrand Jaynes has appeared in three widely separated places:

1) In a letter dated Feb. 11, 1959 written by Mrs. Ellen VanCott of Unandilla, NY to Dr. Ivan P. Jaynes of Erie, PA reference was made to material about Nelson Jaynes that could be found in the library at Cooperstown, NY. Mrs. VanCott enclosed a page of brief notes concerning Jesse Jayne (Janes) and his children. The only children listed were: Hannah Ann Jaynes Foote, b. Dec. 15, 1824, d. Mar. 6, 1883; Nelson Jaynes, m. Rosanna Church; Anthony Jaynes who died in the Masonic Home in Utica, NY; and Legrand Jaynes. The latter name appeared without further data.

2) Letter dated Feb. 27, 1981 written by Relpha Wakefield to Mary Lee Keane .

"This information was given to me by my mother Maudrice L. Stevens Harris shortly before she died in 1966, she was nearly 91." The mother of Maudrice was Myra Asenieth Bedient Stevens and her grandparents were James Henry Bedient and Maria Jaynes. "Legrand Jaynes of Philadelphia was the brother of Maria Jaynes. Legrand Jaynes was mother's favorite uncle. He trained Morgan horses for show horses. He allowed me to drive his famous matched teams although he would not trust his own sons to handle them. He said I had horse sense."

Myra Asenieth Bedient was born in 1854 and died in 1928. She was married to Herbert Lucasian Stevens in 1875. It was she who called Legrand Jaynes her "favorite uncle". It would appear that Legrand Jaynes was alive in say the 1860's or 1870's.

3) Early Years in Smyrna and our first Old home week by George A. Munson, 1905  
p. 173.

In those days when every store was a club room, what stories were related by LeGrand Jaynes, Denison Kelsey, "Ben" Holley and Plumb Smith, and others whose identity escapes me now. Great rovers those fellows were, and all of them could

draw the long bow. Plumb Smith had been in the Mexican war. LeGrand Jaynes made money enough somehow out of the outside world to build a fine house in Smyrna, and he could tell a story which would put to blush the tales of Gulliver or Robinson Crusoe. Long before Horace Greeley began his exhortations to young men to "go West," these travelers and others had fired the heart of many a Smyrna boy to seek his fortune in the great outside world.

JOEL L. JAYNES, now a traveling salesman for Mack, Stader & Co., of Cincinnati, Ohio, resides on Morgan avenue, Parsons, Kan.; was born in Otsego, N. Y., in 1828. **His father's name was Joel Jaynes, his mother's name was Phoebe Jaynes (nee Winton).** His earlier ancestors were Puritans. He received a liberal education in the public district schools. At the age of seventeen years, he learned the shoemaker's trade, and followed it for many years. July 28, 1850, he was married to Adeila D. Barbor, a most excellent and highly accomplished young lady, the daughter of Weightman Barbor and Ruth Barbor (whose maiden name was Record). Both of Mrs. Jaynes's grandfathers were very eminent Baptist preachers. Mr. and Mrs. Jaynes had born to them two daughters - Kate E. and Carrie V. At the breaking out of the Civil War, young Jaynes enlisted as a private soldier in Company F. One Hundred and Fifty-seventh Regiment New York Volunteer Infantry, and after serving two years, being with his regiment most of the time, he was discharged on surgeon's certificate of disability, being sorely afflicted with sciatica. In 1867, he moved his family to Kansas, and was present and assisted in raising the first house that was built in the now prosperous city of Parsons. He is a member in good standing in the following orders: A., F. & A. M., I. O. O. F., Knights of Pythias, A. O. U. W., G. A. R., and Red Men.

All of Wightman and Ruth's children were born in New York; we know from a land purchase record that Wightman was living in Chenango, New York, by 1813, and all of the children were born after that date.

g to the 1820, 1830 and 1840 censuses in Smyrna, Ruth and Wightman had two sons and three daughters. The daughters are known, but the names of the two sons are unknown.

The oldest child, a son, was born between 1816 and 1820. He is living with Wightman and Ruth in the 1820, 1830, and 1840 U.S. Census.

The second son was born between 1821 and 1825, and he must have died before the 1840 census. He is only in the 1830 census.  
[An older male, probably Wightman's father, was living with Wightman and Ruth in the 1820 and 1830 census as well. I do not know where Wightman's father and his youngest son were buried.]

The oldest daughter was Virtue Barbor Bills (~1820-1892), wife of Sidney Bills. She is buried in the same plot as Wightman and Ruth; she had three sons and one of them was named Record after his mother's family.

**Sarah Barbor Jaynes (1822-1899), the second daughter, married Lewis Nelson Jaynes. She was widowed very early in the marriage. She and her husband are buried in Wightman and Ruth's plot as well.**

**Adelia Barbor Jaynes (December 28, 1831-January 13, 1902), the youngest, married Joel Jaynes in 1851; Adelia and Joel had two daughters, Kate Eva and Carrie V Jaynes. Adelia's death record says that she was buried in Parsons, Labette, Kansas.**

The widow Sarah Jaynes, and Adelia Jaynes and her family, moved to Labette County, Kansas after their parents died.

Adelia and her family moved to Kansas in 1868, and then to Philadelphia thirty years later, in 1898. Adelia died in Menominee, Michigan, on January 13, 1901, at age 79, while visiting her daughter, Kate E. Barbor, there.

## GRANDCHILDREN:

Adelia Barbor Jaynes' daughters:

Kate Eva Jaynes married a Hudson, then divorced, then a Barbor, and was widowed; and then a Dixon. She had one son, Ray L. Hudson.

I don't know whether Carrie V. Jaynes married, or what happened to her.

CENSUSES (Ruth and Wightman Barbor):

According to the 1820, 1830 and 1840 censuses in Smyrna, Wightman had a wife, two sons and three daughters.

In the 1820 and 1830 censuses, Wightman had an older male living with him and his family, who may have been Wightman's father. Wightman lived next door to Joshua Barbor and a few doors down from Benjamin Barbor. Amasa Barbor also lived in Smyrna.

In the 1850 U.S. Census in Smyrna, NY, Wightman and his wife Ruth live with their youngest daughter, Adelia Barbor, age 18. Wightman is a carpenter.

In the 1855 NY State census, Wightman and Ruth are the only two in the household. Wightman is a carpenter.

In the 1860 U.S. Census, Wightman and his wife Ruth live in the home of their daughter, Adelia Barbor Jaynes, with her and her husband and two daughters. Sarah Barbor Jaynes, age 38 and now widowed, lives there as well. Wightman is a carpenter.
